



Packing List

Items that are **supplied** at most of the cottages:

- All kitchen items necessary for preparing, serving and cleaning up in the kitchen. Including dish soap, sponges, Brillo, garbage bags, paper towels, cloth towels. There are some condiments such as salt and pepper, sugar and tea.
- There is a microwave, drip coffee machine and filters, and toaster. Full-size frig, stove, oven, dishwasher. Cutting boards, knives, cork screw, can opener. All dishes, pots, skillets, coffee mugs, glasses and silverware.
- TV/VCR /DVD- basic TV reception with the exception of the Turtleshell cabin.
- CD/ player/radio
- Queen size bed made up with quality linen, blankets and quilts
- Bath products such as toilet paper, tissues, paper towels and hand soap.
- Firewood is supplied along with kindling and newspaper
- There is an outdoor charcoal grill ready and barbecue utensils are supplied

Items that you need **to bring**:

- Food and beverage
- There are some games, books and magazines, CDs, videos/DVDs but you might want to pack your own.
- CD player / MP3 player speakers
- Towels for the bath and swimming
- Extra blanket or pillow
- Bath soap, Shampoo, hair dryer, basic first aid
- Always good to have a flashlight.
- Charcoal/ Tin Foil.
- Camera, binoculars, back pack, water bottle, hiking boots
- The cottages have phones but not private lines. You will need a 1-800 pre-paid calling card. There is no cell service directly in the cabin. A 10 min drive up the mt you can get service and certain spots on the property. Leave our number for emergency- 570-685-7001

In the warmer months:

- Insect repellent, citronella candles, picnic cooler, bathing suit, sun block, fishing gear
- Paper plates, cups, napkins, etc.
- Rubber soled sandals for the river and creek or old sneakers
- Tubes or rafts to float around – we have a compressor
