Arriving at Sylvania Tree Farm Camp Sites

(Please read and forward this to all members in your group)

Fireworks are NOT permitted on campground or adjoining Sylvania Tree Farm property.

There will be an added waste removal charge of 5.00 per person per stay. Bring garbage bags and we will pick up at site and dispose of.

Children must wear life jacket and be accompanied by an adult when swimming, wading or playing in river

There is an <u>active rail line near</u> river campsites. The railroad crossing has no gates or lights. When approaching the crossing always come to a <u>complete stop</u> with vehicle then look and listen for trains.

The road leading to the river campsites (Mast Hope Ave) is not posted with a speed limit, however, <u>do not exceed 15 mph</u>

Generators are not permitted at the campgrounds

Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. Be courteous and clean up after them around campsite and swimming areas.

On the day of your arrival allow for enough time to be able to check-in and setup your camp before dark. GPS address to our home office is 112 Mast Hope Ave Lackawaxen PA. Arrive and register and we will take you to your site. Text or call 570-955-7729 with updates on arrival. No arrivals after 10pm or before 8AM

A Pennsylvania or New York state fishing license is required to fish on Delaware River for persons over the age of 16. A Pennsylvania Fishing license is required to fish any inland waters for persons over the age of 16. A trout stamp is required in addition to your fishing license when specifically fishing for trout. PA fishing license can be purchased on-line at https://www.pa.wildlifelicense.com/start.php.
